#### WHAT IS A PLATELET DONATION?

A platelet donation is an automated donation that collects the platelet portion of your blood, while the remaining blood components are returned during the donation. The main function of a platelet is to interact with clotting proteins to prevent or stop bleeding.

## WHAT CAN SOMEONE EXPECT WHEN THEY GIVE A PLATELET DONATION?

A platelet donation is an automated donation that allows the donor to give six times the number of platelets normally collected during a whole blood donation. During this special donation process, a machine is used to safely collect your platelets and return your red blood cells and plasma, along with some saline. It takes a generous person to donate platelets, as the donation can take up to two hours. To pass time during your donation, you will be able to listen to music, connect to WiFi, or watch TV.

#### **IS THE DONATION PROCESS SAFE?**

Absolutely! All materials used during a platelet donation, including bags and needles, are new, sterile, and used only once.


#### WHY GIVE PLATELETS?

Platelets are essential for life, as they help control bleeding. When a blood vessel is damaged, platelets collect at the site of the injury and activate substances in plasma which form a clot and allow the wound to heal. Platelets are transfused frequently for:

- Cancer and Leukemia patients
- Burn patients
- Transplant recipients
- Heart surgery
- Patients suffering from bleeding disorders

# **PLATELETS**


Colorless cell fragements in blood whose main function is to help prevent or stop bleeding and stick to the lining of blood vessels.



#### **WHO CAN GIVE PLATELETS?**

We are currently only able to accept new platelet donations from males due to extensive testing requirements necessary to accept new female donors. Platelet donors must meet the general blood donor eligibility requirements below:

- Weigh at least 120 pounds and be in general good health
- Be at least 16 years of age or older (with a signed parental/guardian consent form)
- Do not take medication containing aspirin
  48 hours prior to donating



## HOW OFTEN CAN SOMEONE DONATE PLATELETS?

Donors are eligible to give platelets every two weeks, up to 24 times per year. Since platelets can only be stored for five days, the need for platelet donors is urgent.
